

Installation Instruction for Shadow SH 882 Blues Pro Pedal

Content:

Foot pedal,
Rubber feet

1. Put a 9V battery into the battery holder at the bottom side.
2. Connect your instrument to the pedal by using a stereo cable (input).
3. Put mono cable from the output to your amplifier.
4. Put the Blend-potentiometer in desired position.
5. With EQ-Shape shift (back side) you can choose between linear and enhanced sound.
6. Parametric-EQ contains 3 potentiometers:
 - a. Contour
 - b. Frequency
 - c. Width

Parametric-EQ has no effect if Contour-potentiometer is in middle-position. With the Frequency-potentiometer you make setting for the frequency, which will raise or lower with the Contour-potentiometer (right: raise; left: lower). With the Width-potentiometer you adjust the bandwidth of the chosen frequency.

7. The Phase-shifter turns the phase of the whole system, which helps you to suppress feedback.
8. The Notch-Filter on the back side eliminates the feedback-frequency.

ATTENTION: Make sure, that the signal of the piezo-pickup is connected to the tip and the signal of the condenser-microphone is connected to the ring-contact of the stereo output jack of the instrument.

The battery turns on automatically when you plug the cable in. To spare battery life, take the cable out when you are finished.
